Developing a Sustainable Limestone Coast Leadership Program (LCLP)

Many regional and remote communities struggle to develop and retain their leadership capacity, both in quantity of leaders and extent of their skills. Extensive research has evidenced a demand for a regional leadership program in the Limestone Coast and that such a program would benefit business, the broader economy and communities in our region. The intention is to put in place a framework that enables delivery of a long-term sustainable leadership program, sponsored by business, community, government and philanthropic organisations in the Limestone Coast with regional economic and social benefits beyond the project deliverables.

There is great leadership potential in the Limestone Coast but it needs to be stimulated and fostered through more conscious investment in leadership skill development.

Developing and supporting leaders in our region will enable us to realise our opportunities and address our challenges.

The 10-month program, delivered by The Leaders Institute of South Australia, will be held across various locations throughout the Limestone Coast. It will be open to individuals from across the region who are ready to broaden their leadership capabilities and impact through personal growth, self-empowerment and relationship development.

The Program will predominantly be delivered face to face, facilitating vital interaction and enabling strong relationships to be forged between participants.

Places are limited, and a robust selection process ensures participants are genuine about their leadership journey and that they are drawn from diverse backgrounds.
